In the reference cited, Government of Andhra Pradesh have issued orders revising the rates of Dearness Allowance to the State Government employees in Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales, 2015 from 8.908% of basic pay to 12.052% of the basic pay from 1st January, 2015. It is decided to implement orders issued in the reference cited revision DA w.e.f. January 2015 to the Corporation employees and release arrears in cash w.e.f. January 2015 to February 2016 @ 3.144% on the basic pay.

In view of the enhancement of DA from 8.908% to 12.052%, the General Manager (Finance), all District Managers and Zonal Managers, APSCSCL are hereby requested to revise DA from January 2015 pay bills onwards and draw the DA arrears from 1st January 2015 to February 2016 @ 3.144% on the basic pay and make payment of arrears in cash, and D.A sanctioned shall be paid in cash with the salary of March 2016 payable in April 2016, in respect of the employees of Corporation.

Regarding the Deputationists working in the Corporation, the DA arrears shall be drawn in terms of Para 11 of the G.O. The revised DA shall be paid in cash with the salary of March, 2016. The arrears on account of payment of Dearness Allowance from 1st January 2015 to 29th February 2016 shall be credited to General Provident Fund account of the respective employees.

The IOCPF of DA arrears (January 2015 to February 2016) shall be sent to Head Office along with March 2016 IOCPF. The DA arrears bill is to be drawn to all those who are in the pay rolls during the period covered in G.O now communicated.

ORDER:

Government hereby order the revision of Dearness Allowance (DA) sanctioned in the Government Orders fifth read above to the employees of Government of Andhra Pradesh drawing pay in the Andhra Pradesh Revised Pay Scales, 2015 from 8.908 % of the basic pay to 12.052 % of basic pay from 1st January, 2015.

2. The Dearness Allowance sanctioned in the above para shall also be payable to:

- i) The employees of Zilla Parishad, Mandal Parishad, Gram Panchayats, Municipalities, Municipal Corporations, Agricultural Market Committees and Zilla Grandhalaya Samasthas, Work Charged Establishment, who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015
- ii) Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of Aided Institutions including Aided Polytechnics who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015.
- iii) Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of Universities including Acharya N.G. Ranga Agricultural University and Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University who are drawing pay in a regular scale of pay in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015.

3. Government also hereby order the revision of Dearness Allowance rates in respect of State Government employees drawing the Revised U.G.C Pay Scales, 2006, from 107% to 113% of the basic pay with effect from 1st January, 2015.
