1% driage charge to the designated rice mills w.e.f.  
KMS 2015-16 –procedure to be adopted-Reg.

addressed to all the JC & EOEDs, APSCSCL.

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The GOI have communicated the provisional costing sheet for the crop year KMS 2015-16 and 1% driage has been allowed to the State Government Agencies (SGAs) for the storage of paddy during paddy procurement operations. The GOI have given the provision to the storage agencies keeping in view of the natural driage during storage of paddy for custom milling. The APSCSCL has made arrangements to shift the paddy immediately after purchases from respective PPCs directly to the designated rice mills without intermediary storage. The rice millers are storing the paddy in their respective premises until completion of the CMR deliveries to CSC/FCI. In view of the above, the Rice Mill premises itself treated as storage point.

The GOI defines driage loss as a loss in the quantity of food gain due to reduction in moisture content during storage. It is allowed in case of paddy during storage at acquisition stage (for raw rice only). Therefore, the State Rice Millers Associations have representing to allow them to entitle 1% driage as they are the custodians of the paddy on behalf of APSCSCL and sustaining loss on natural driage. The requests of the Rice Millers Associations were examined in detail and therefore instructions were issued vide ref. 2<sup>nd</sup> cited allowing driage charges to the rice millers as per the GOI guidelines.

The Driage on paddy is allowed only in case of Raw Rice and not allowed for Boiled Rice. The 1% driage is allowed on the quantity of Custom Milled Raw Rice delivered during the season as per provisional

cost sheet @ Rs.14.50 per quintal for Grade. A and Rs.14.10 per quintal for Common. The 1% driage shall be passed on to the rice millers w.e.f. KMS 2015-16. The 1% driage is to be passed on to the designated rice millers along with custom milling charges only after completion of the 100% CMR deliveries against the paddy supplied to the miller during the season i.e., the designated rice miller shall deliver the resultant rice under CMR to the designated godown proportionate to the paddy supplied to him @67% for Raw Rice. No balance CMR is left undelivered by him.

For the CMR stocks (Raw rice) delivered to FCI under Central Pool, the 1% driage shall be passed on to the millers after realization of the same from FCI. The DMs shall prefer the claims with FCI along with necessary documentation and certify mill-wise paddy receipts and CMR deliveries under stock flow statement.

**Procedure for preferring claims by designated Rice Millers:**

- The claim should indicate clearly the details of paddy receipts & CMR deliveries i.e. date wise / variety wise along with the following documents.
- A stock flow statement for calculation of 1% driage (Proforma enclosed).
- A copy of proof of designation of Mill by the District Administration.
- Copies of acknowledgments against receipt of paddy.
- Copies of ACKs towards deliveries of Custom Milled Raw Rice.

All the JC & EOEDs of APSCSCL are requested to settle the claims towards 1% driage as per the above guidelines.
