As the prices of edible oils in the open market are showing an upward trend, Government issued orders for distribution of P.Oil to the BPL cardholders @ 1 litre pouch of P.Oil per card through all F.P.Shops in the districts at subsidized price as a measure of relief to the common man.

In the reference 1st cited, Govt. of India have allotted a quantity of 13,000 Mts. of P.Oil per month for distribution to the BPL cardholders through PDS monthly for 3 months of April, May and June, 2008.

In the reference 2nd cited, Government has issued orders that the APSCSCL shall purchase 13,000 Mts. of Palmolien Oil in 1 litre pouches per month from M/s MMTC as per the allocation made by the Government of India to be delivered at Kakinada, transport to all the MLS Points and from there to all the F.P.Shops immediately for commencing distribution to all white cardholders in the district from July, 2008 onwards at an end consumer price of Rs.45/- per 1 litre pouch, which includes the handling and transportation charges to the Corporation and margin to the F.P.Shop dealers. In the said GO it has also been ordered that the difference between the economic cost and the end consumer price fixed by the government for P.Oil for the entire transactions will be reimbursed to the Corporation from the Market Intervention Fund provided for the year 2008-2009.

In the reference 3rd cited, Commissioner of Civil Supplies has re-allotted quantity of 13,000 Mts. (14,286 KLS) to the districts as indicated in the attachment. Copy of the same is enclosed herewith.

In view of the above, the following instructions are hereby issued to all the District Managers to commence the distribution of Palmolien Oil from July, 2008 onwards.

1. The MMTC, Public Sector Undertaking will supply RBD P Oil in pouches packed by M/s Acalmar and M/s Ruchi Infrastrure at Kakinada.
2. The P.Oil pouches have to be transported to the MLS points in the districts through Zonal Transport Contractors appointed by the Corporation.
3. The Zonal Manager, APSCSCL, Vijayawada is appointed as Nodal Officer for P.Oil transactions at Kakinada with supporting staff. The Nodal Officer may authorize his representative to receive P.Oil Pouches from MMTC or their processors for loading into the trucks of the transport contractors for movement as per the allotments given by the Joint Collectors. He should inform the dispatch particulars to the District Manager, Kakinada and destination District Managers and Head Office on day to day basis over phone / through fax / e mail.
4. An application in the e-office is developed to enter daily dispatch particulars. The Nodal Officer shall ensure entry of all dispatch particulars in the said application every day after completion of transactions. Detailed instructions in this regard are being issued.
5. Payments to the MMTC will be made at Head Office depending on the delivery schedule of MMTC. The Nodal Officer / District Manager Kakinada should collect the Delivery Orders from MMTC. The Head Office will pursue for positioning sufficient stocks in time as per the allotment.
6. The District Manager, APSCSCL, concerned shall make payment transportation charges basing on the acknowledgements and confirmation of stocks as per the agreement daily deducting Service Tax and Income Tax.
