In the reference cited, the Government of India has informed that it
has been decided to adopt **BLUE** Colour Coding for gunny bags for RMS
2016-17. The colour coding will be in the manner indicated below.

1. On every bag, there will be Colour Coded strip/s for identification
marking at a distance of about 150 mm away from any one side of
the selvedge. Each strip will be width of "**04 threads running
along the length of the Bag**" shall be in "**BLUE**" colour. Single
strip is printed for bags to be supplied through DGS&D. For open
market supply to millers etc., two strips should be printed on both
side of centre stripe as in Para below.
2. Stencil or branding as per indenter's requirements shall be in
"**BLUE**" colour.
3. Marking or stitching on the mouth of the bag after filling the grain
will be done by the FCI/State Agencies in "**BLUE**" colour.

The VC & Managing Director, A.P.State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd is
requested to take necessary action in the matter.

Sir,

I am directed to say that it has been decided to adopt **BLUE** Colour Coding for gunny bags for RMS 2016-17. The colour coding will be in the manner indicated below:

1. On every bag, there will be Color Coded strip/s for identification marking at a distance of about 150 mm away from any one side of the selvedge. Each strip will be width of "04 threads running along the length of the Bag" and shall be in "BLUE" color. Single strip is to be printed for bags to be supplied through DGS&D. For open market supply to millers etc., two strips should be printed on both side of centre stripe as mentioned in para below.
2. Stencil or Branding as per indenters' requirements shall be in "BLUE" colour.
3. Marking or stitching on the mouth of the bag after filling the grain will be done by the FCI/State Agencies in "BLUE" colour.
