**Corrigendum**

Sub: APSCSCL Tenders called for appointment of packing agency for packing of Fine Quality Rice in 25kg packing form – Pre-bid meeting conducted – certain quires raised by participants – Issue of revised Corrigendum - Req.

Ref: 1) Tender Notification dt.05.06.2026  
2) Minutes of the Pre-Bid Meeting dt.08.06.2026.

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In the references 1st and 2nd cited, a pre-bid meeting was conducted with the prospective bidders for the tender invited for the appointment of a packing agency for packing Fine Quality Rice into 25 kg packets. During the meeting, certain issues and concerns were raised by the participants, and decisions were taken thereon after considering their requests and suggestions. Accordingly, a corrigendum dated 09.06.2026 was issued.

However, it has been noticed that Clause No. 1.3 of the tender document erroneously included the scope of loading the packed rice into trucks. Therefore, the following modification is hereby made:
